On this 28th day of March, 2013, the Iowa Dental Board and Irene M. Broyles, D.D.S., each hereby agree as follows:

The licensee disciplinary hearing scheduled before the Iowa Dental Board on the February 1, 2013, shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the parties have agreed to the following Settlement Agreement and Final Order:

1. Respondent was issued a license to practice dentistry on the 12th day of August, 1994, as evidenced by license number 07737 which is recorded in the permanent records in the office of the Iowa Dental Board.
2. Respondent's Iowa dental license number 07737 is currently lapsed.
3. The Iowa Dental Board has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter herein.
4. A Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges was filed against Respondent on October 25th, 2012.
5. Respondent's dental license is on lapsed status.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that should Respondent decide to reinstate her Iowa dental license in the future she would be placed on probation for a period of five (5) years and subject to the to the following terms and conditions:

SECTION I.

1. At the time she requests reinstatement of her Iowa dental license, Respondent agrees to submit a civil penalty in the amount of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) to the Iowa Dental Board, made payable to Treasurer, State of Iowa; to be deposited in the general fund.
2. Respondent shall fully comply with all of the terms set forth in the Final Order Terminating License Suspension and Implementing License Probation for Five Years, filed by the Kansas Dental Board on January 10, 2012; and in the Settlement Agreement between Missouri Dental Board and Irene Aves Broyles, D.D.S., filed by the Missouri Dental Board on April 1, 2011.
3. Respondent shall submit quarterly reports detailing her compliance with the terms and conditions of the Orders of the Kansas and Missouri Dental Boards during the remainder of her probationary period. Respondent shall ensure that the reports are submitted prior to the first day of January, April, July, and October, of each calendar year during the probationary period.
4. Respondent shall be responsible for all costs associated with compliance with this agreement, and shall also be responsible for all costs incurred by the Board in the monitoring of this agreement to determine compliance. Respondent shall promptly remit one hundred (\$100.00) dollars on or before the first day of January, April, July, and October, of each calendar year for monitoring costs.
5. Respondent shall fully cooperate with the Board to determine compliance with this Agreement.
6. Respondent's Iowa dental license is currently inactive. In the event Respondent returns to practice dentistry in Iowa before the expiration of her probation,

Respondent will submit for Board approval a practice monitoring plan consistent with the provisions of the Kansas and Missouri Orders. Respondent agrees not to practice in Iowa before that practice monitoring plan is approved by the Board.


SECTION II.

1. Respondent acknowledges that she has read in its entirety the foregoing Settlement Agreement and Final Order and that she understands its content and that she executed the Order freely, voluntarily, and with no mental reservation whatsoever.
2. Respondent acknowledges she has a right to a hearing in this matter, and she hereby waives that right.
3. Respondent acknowledges that she has the right to be represented by counsel in this matter.
4. Respondent understands that this Order is a public record and is therefore subject to inspection and copying by members of the public.
5. Respondent understands that the Board will report this Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank and Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank.
6. Respondent acknowledges that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney for the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured her, in any way whatsoever, to execute this Order.
7. Respondent acknowledges that this proposed settlement is subject to approval of a majority of the full Board. If the Board fails to approve this proposed settlement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
8. Respondent shall fully and promptly comply with all Orders of the Board and the statutes and rules regulating the practice of dentistry in Iowa. Any violation of the terms of this Order is grounds for further disciplinary action, upon notice and

opportunity for hearing, for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 272C.3(2)(a)(2011).

9. The Board's approval of this Settlement Agreement and Final Order shall constitute a FINAL ORDER of the Board.

This Settlement Agreement and Final Order is voluntarily submitted on this 19 day of February, 2013.
