You are hereby notified that on January 13, 2005, the Board found probable cause to file a Statement of Charges against you. If any of the allegations against you are founded, the Board has authority to take disciplinary action against you under Iowa Code chapters 17A, 147, 153, and 272C (2003), and 650 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 51. A copy of the Statement of Charges is attached, and sets forth the particular statutes and rules which you are alleged to have violated, and further provides a short and plain statement of the matters asserted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a disciplinary contested case hearing be held upon the Statement of Charges on April 15, 2005, before the full Board or a panel of the Board. The hearing shall begin at 1:00 p.m. and shall be located in the 1st Floor Conference Room, Iowa Board of Dental Examiners at 400 SW 8th Street, Ste D, Des Moines, Iowa. The Board shall serve as presiding officer, but the Board may request an Administrative

Law Judge make initial rulings on prehearing matters, and be present to assist and advise the Board at hearing.

Within twenty (20) days of the date you are served with the Statement of Charges and Notice of Hearing, you are required by 650 Iowa Administrative Code 51.12(2) to file an Answer to the Charges. In that Answer, you should also state whether you will require an adjustment of the date and time of the hearing.

At hearing, you may appear personally or be represented by counsel at your own expense. You will be allowed the opportunity to respond to the Charges against you. The procedural rules governing the conduct of the hearing are found at 650 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 51.

The office of the Attorney General is responsible for representing the public interest (the State) in this proceeding. Pleadings shall be filed with the Board and copies should be provided to counsel for the State at the following address:

If you fail to appear at the hearing, the Board may enter a default decision or proceed with the hearing and render a decision in your absence, in accordance with Iowa Code section 17A.12(3) and 650 Iowa Administrative Code 51.22.

This matter may be resolved by settlement agreement. The procedural rules governing the Board's settlement process are found at 650 Iowa Administrative Code

- 1) The Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to Iowa Code Chapters 153 and 272C (2003).
- 2) Respondent is currently issued Registration number Q03870 to engage in dental assisting, subject to the laws of the State of Iowa and the rules of the Board.
- 3) Registration number Q03870 is currently on probationary status and expires June 30, 2005.

COUNT I


The Respondent is charged under Iowa Code Section 153.34(14) (2003) with the inability to practice dental assisting with reasonable skill and safety by reason of illness, drunkenness, or habitual or excessive use of drugs, intoxicants, narcotics, chemicals, or other types of materials.

THE CIRCUMSTANCES

1. Respondent's registration is currently on probationary status as a result of an April 22, 2004, Board action. The circumstances of that action involved Respondent abusing nitrous oxide and that she may be chemically dependant on prescription medications.
2. The Board received new information alleging that Respondent may be using an illicit drug.
3. Respondent subsequently consented to a urinalysis that confirmed the presence of an illicit drug.
4. Respondent admits to regularly using this drug.

On this day 13th day of January, 2005, the Iowa Board of Dental

Examiners found probable cause to file this Statement of Charges and to order a hearing in this case.
