


issued Respondent a Letter of Warning following his personal appearance before the members of the Board on April 14, 2005.

5. Another follow up was done in August 2006 and Respondent again failed to address the Board's concerns with regards to record keeping. Respondent was provided with resources to help him address the record keeping issues.
6. In October 2006, during a compliance check, Respondent stated that he had discontinued practice and that he was leaving the state in two (2) days. Respondent stated that since he knew he was leaving, he didn't address the issues pending before the Board.
7. Multiple patient records were subpoenaed from Respondent's practice in October 2006 for review. These records fail to meet minimum standards as required by 650 Iowa Administrative Code 27.11.

On this 30th day of November, 2006, the Iowa Board of Dental

Examiners found probable cause to this file this Statement of Matters Asserted.

**STIPULATION AND
CONSENT ORDER**

On this 18th day of April, 2007, the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners and Michael J. Low, D.D.S., 814 Seventh Avenue, Camanche, Iowa, each hereby agree with the other and stipulate as follows:

The licensee disciplinary hearing scheduled to commence before the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners on the 18th day of April, 2007, and was continued on February 1, 2007 until further Order of the Board on the allegations specified in the Statement of Matters Asserted which is attached to the Notice of Hearing dated November 30, 2006, shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the parties have agreed to the following Stipulation and Consent Order:

1. That Respondent was issued a license to practice dentistry on the 1st day of July, 1978, as evidenced by License Number 6365, which is recorded in Book D, Page 16, of the permanent records in the office of the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners.
2. That Iowa Dental License Number 6365 is current until June 30, 2008.
3. That Respondent's dental license is on probation until August 30, 2008.

4. That the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter herein.
5. A Notice of Hearing and Statement of Matters Asserted was filed against Respondent on November 30, 2006.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent is hereby **CITED** for noncompliance with an Order of the Board, and for failing to maintain appropriate dental records, and is hereby **WARNED** that further violations of the law governing the practice of dentistry may result in additional disciplinary action, including revocation or suspension of his dental license.

SECTION I.

1. Respondent's dental license shall be immediately suspended for a period of two (2) weeks effective with the date of this Order.
2. Respondent shall submit a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

SECTION II.

Prior to the return to the practice of dentistry in the state of Iowa or under his Iowa dental license, Respondent shall:

1. Successfully complete a continuing dental education course on dental record keeping to include periodontal care record keeping. The record keeping course is to be approved by the Board or its designee in advance of Respondent's attendance. Prior to resuming practice in Iowa, Respondent is to submit a proposed dental record keeping system and plan for its implementation for Board approval.
2. Respondent shall successfully complete the Iowa dental jurisprudence examination.
3. Respondent shall contract with a Board approved Iowa licensed dentist to serve as a practice monitor to review Respondent's patient record keeping and periodontal protocols.

The practice monitor shall be required to regularly report all findings to the Board. Respondent shall upon a timeframe approved by the Board submit names and a detailed monitoring plan to the Board for approval.

4. Following a period of full compliance with the terms of this Order, Respondent may request modification of the terms of this section.

SECTION III.


The Board shall review the documentation to determine compliance with the requirements set forth in Section II. If the Board determines Respondent has complied with the requirements the Board shall issue an Order allowing Respondent to return to practice subject to terms of probation for a period of three (3) years.

SECTION IV.

1. Respondent acknowledges that he has read in its entirety the foregoing Stipulation and Consent Order and that he understands its content and that he has executed the Stipulation and Consent Order freely and voluntarily.
2. Respondent agrees this Stipulation and Consent Order constitutes the resolution of a pending contested case. By entering into this Stipulation and Consent Order, the Respondent voluntarily waives any right to a contested case hearing on allegations contained in the Notice of Hearing and Statement of Matters Asserted, and waives any objections to the terms of this Stipulation and Consent Order.
3. Respondent acknowledges that he is represented by counsel in this matter.
4. Respondent understands that this Stipulation and Consent Order and the attached Statement of Matters Asserted become public records available for inspection and copying upon execution of this agreement in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code Chapters 17A, 22 and 272C.

5. Respondent understands the Board is required by Federal law to report this Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank and Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank.
6. Respondent acknowledges that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney for the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured him, in any way whatsoever, to execute this Order.
7. Respondent acknowledges that this proposed settlement is subject to approval of a majority of the full Board. If the Board fails to approve this proposed settlement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
8. Respondent shall fully and promptly comply with all Orders of the Board and the statutes and rules regulating the practice of dentistry in Iowa. Any violation of this Order is grounds for further disciplinary action, upon notice and opportunity for hearing, for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 272C.3(2)(a) (2007).
9. The Board's approval of this Stipulation and Consent Order shall constitute a **FINAL ORDER** of the Board.


