**STIPULATION AND
CONSENT ORDER**

On this 17th day of June, 2004, the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners and Richard E. Workman, D.M.D., 1200 Network Centre Dr., Ste. 2, each hereby agree with the other and stipulate as follows:

The licensee disciplinary hearing scheduled to commence before the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners on the 21st day of May, 2004, on the allegations specified in the Statement of Charges which is attached to the Notice of Hearing dated January 4, 2004, shall be resolved without proceeding to hearing, as the parties have agreed to the following Stipulation and Consent Order:

1. That Respondent was issued a license to practice dentistry on the 30th day of October, 2000, as evidenced by License Number 8076, which is recorded in Book D, Page 76, of the permanent records in the office of the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners.
2. That Iowa Dental License Number 8076 is current and in full force until June 30, 2004.
3. That the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter herein.

4. A Notice of Hearing and Statement of Charges was filed against Respondent on January 4, 2004.

SECTION I.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent is hereby **CITED** and **WARNED** for violating the Board's rules governing the practice of dentistry, by failing to report to the Board instances of gross or continually faulty treatment by another licensee, in violation of Iowa Administrative Code 27.6(1).

SECTION II.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

1. Respondent agrees to comply with legal reporting requirements concerning acts and omissions of other licensees.
2. Respondent shall successfully pass a written jurisprudence examination at the office of the Board. Such examination shall be completed within sixty (60) days of the date of this Order.
3. Respondent agrees to remit to the Iowa Board of Dental Examiners a civil penalty in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) within sixty (60) days of the date of this Order.
4. Respondent shall upon reasonable notice, and subject to the provisions of Board rule 650 Iowa Administrative Code 31.6, appear before the Board at the time and place designated by the Board.
5. Respondent shall be responsible for all costs associated with compliance with this Order, and shall also be responsible for all costs incurred in the monitoring of this Order to determine compliance. Respondent shall promptly remit for such costs.

6. The Respondent shall fully cooperate with random unannounced office visits by agents of the Board to determine compliance with this Order.
7. Any changes in the Respondent's address shall be reported to the Board within fourteen (14) days of the change. This address shall include the full street name, any unit number, city, state, and zip code, and any separate mailing address, including the effective date of change.

SECTION III.


1. The Respondent acknowledges that he has read in its entirety the foregoing Stipulation and Consent Order and that he understands its content and that he enters into this Order freely and voluntarily.
2. Respondent agrees this Stipulation and Consent Order constitutes the resolution of a pending contested case. By entering into this Stipulation and Consent Order, the Respondent voluntarily waives any right to a contested case hearing on allegations contained in the Statement of Charges, and waives any objections to this Stipulation and Consent Order.
3. Respondent acknowledges that he has the right to be represented by counsel in this matter.
4. Respondent understands that this Order is a public record and is therefore subject to inspection and copying by members of the public.
5. Respondent understands that the Board will report this Order to the National Practitioner Data Bank and Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank.
6. Respondent acknowledges that no member of the Board, nor any employee, nor attorney for the Board, has coerced, intimidated, or pressured him, in any way whatsoever, to execute this Order.


7. Respondent acknowledges that this proposed settlement is subject to approval of a majority of the full Board. If the Board fails to approve this proposed settlement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.
8. Respondent shall fully and promptly comply with all Orders of the Board and the statutes and rules regulating the practice of dentistry in Iowa. Any violation of the terms of this Order is grounds for further disciplinary action, upon notice and opportunity for hearing, for failure to comply with an Order of the Board, in accordance with Iowa Code Section 272C.3(2)(a) (2003).

This Stipulation and Consent Order is voluntarily submitted on this 4th day of ^{May} ~~April~~, 2004.


